

## Intermediate Art Homework Assignments

Due Date	Assignment	Objectives
8/30	Draw what you feel you are <b>best at drawing</b> . Show an example of your strengths.	Demonstrate your own personal voice and style
9/13	Design 4 unique <b>geometric patterns</b> that could be used in a commercial design.	Good craftsmanship (use ruler/ templates), interesting design (who is your audience?)
9/27	Take 15 <b>images</b> of Architecture (Outdoors)	Try to get interesting angles/ perspectives. Show overlapping and variety of textures
10/11	<b>Design a NEW cover</b> for your favorite album	Consider the personality of the group as well as the songs while making artistic choices
11/8	<b>Practice foreshortening</b> - draw an arm or leg coming TOWARD you in context: meaning it must be attached to the body (do not have to draw the whole person)	Demonstrate how the hand or foot looks unusually large because of the distance between the body and the viewer. Some of the arm or leg will NOT be viewable.
11/22	<b>Practice Perspective</b> - draw an interior or exterior view of a building. Must show 1 or 2 point perspective.	Use a ruler! Straight lines should be straight! Tip: draw horizon line and vanishing point before beginning the building. Can be a close-up as long as it still shows perspective.
12/13	<b>100 straight line design</b> (2D or 3D)	How creative can you be with 100 straight lines? Can you create a curve? A design? An objective image? Can be 2D (use a ruler) or 3D (popsicle sticks or toothpicks maybe)
